#### Dear Mr. Nguyen:

Your letter dated January 17, 2024 requested an allocation of State SB 198 funds and Federal Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-saving Transportation (PROTECT) funds from the Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program (LTCAP) for project (project location: Area bounded by Locust Avenue on the north, State Route 60 freeway on the south, Moreno Beach Drive on the east, and Nason Street on the west.).
