SUMMARY

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) 2025 Regional Conference and General Assembly is scheduled for Thursday, May 1, 2025. At this meeting, the SCAG membership will consider and take action on resolutions and/or bylaws that establish SCAG policy.

An important part of the Regional Conference is the conducting of the Annual Business

at the General Assembly. The City must designate a voting delegate and an alternate, one of whom may vote in the event that the designated voting delegate is unable to serve. Designation of a voting delegate must be done by City Council action.

SCAG has requested attending cities to submit a Minute Excerpt of the Council action appointing the City's voting delegate and alternate.

Staff recommends that Council by motion vote to appoint a delegate and an alternate.
