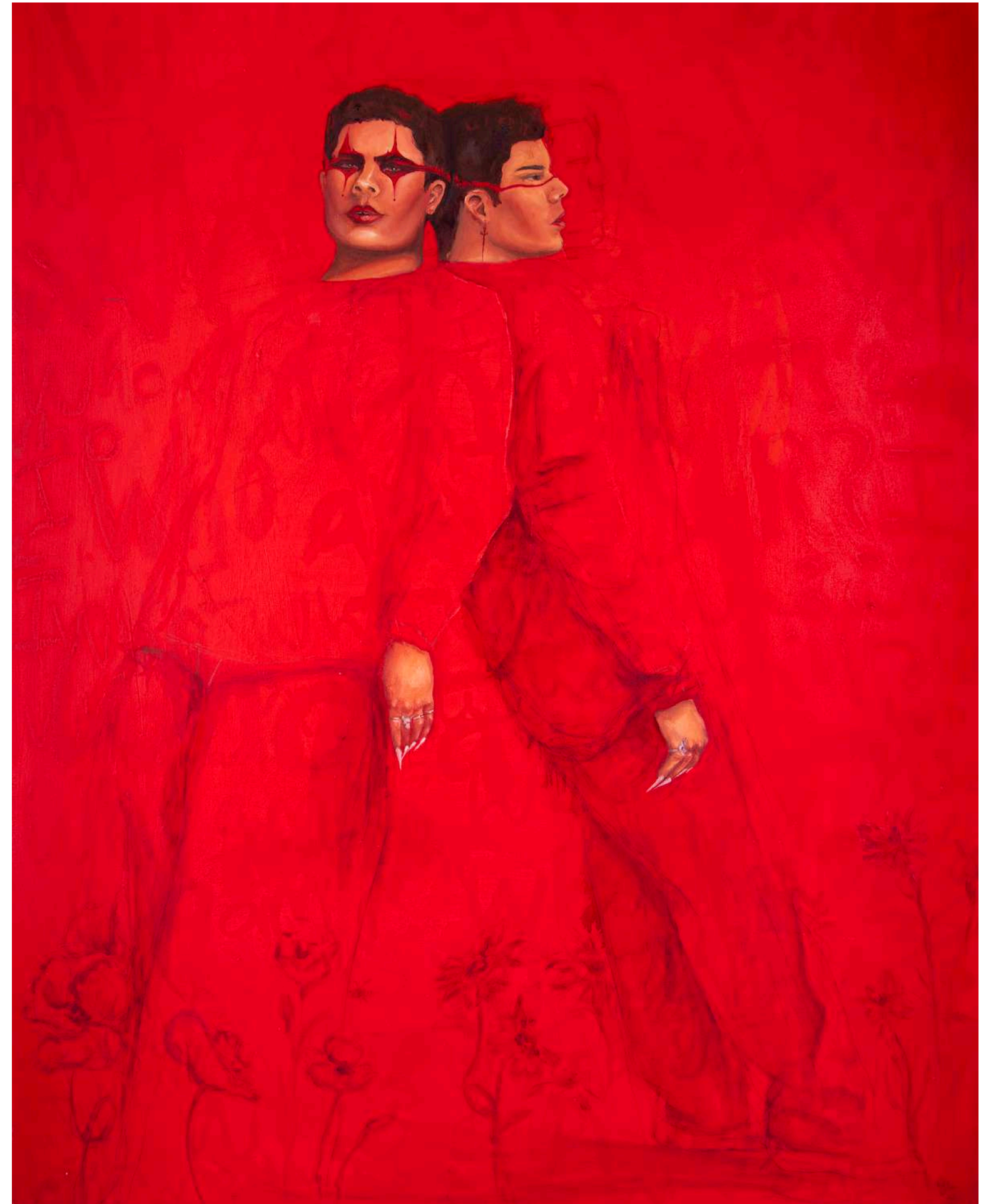

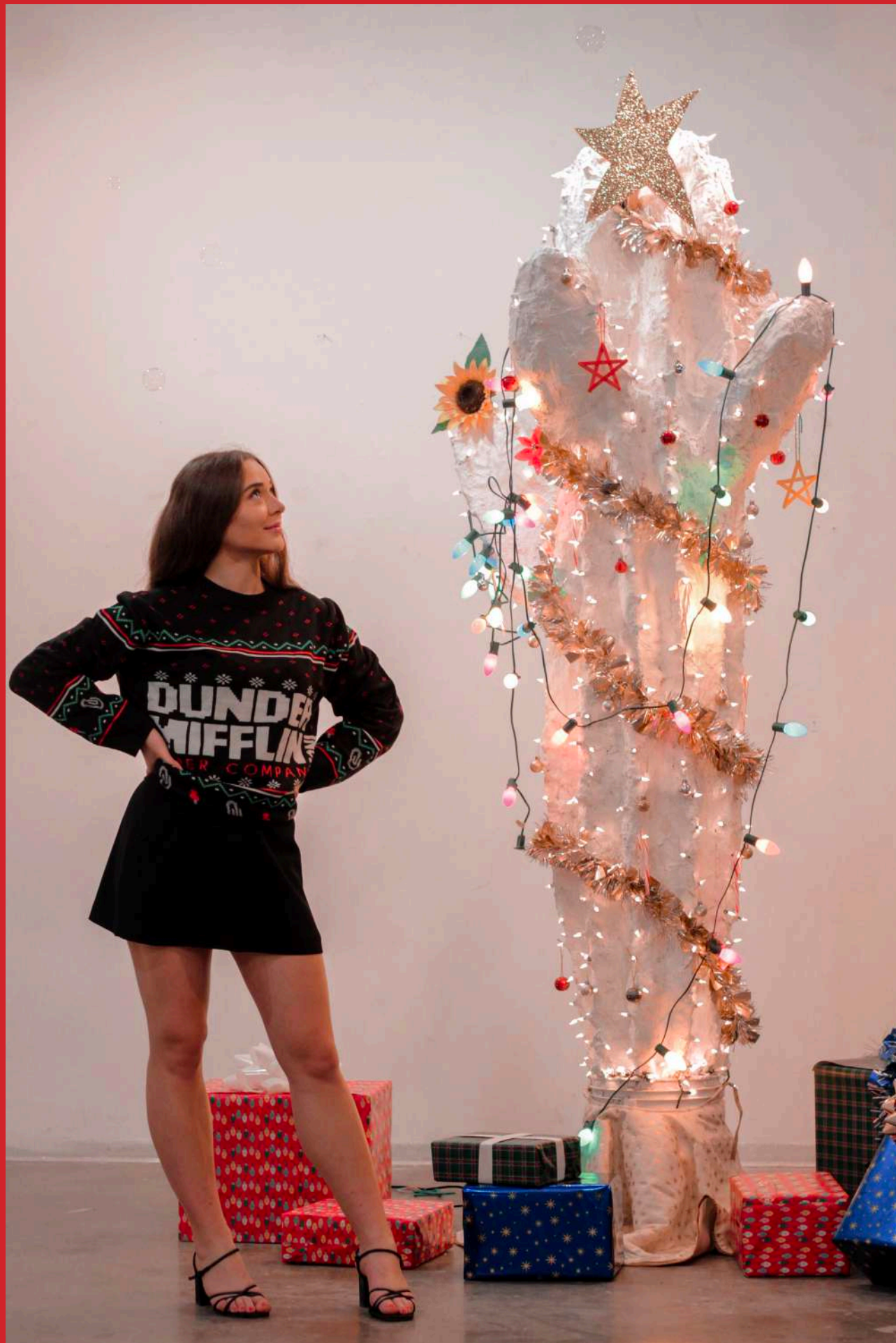

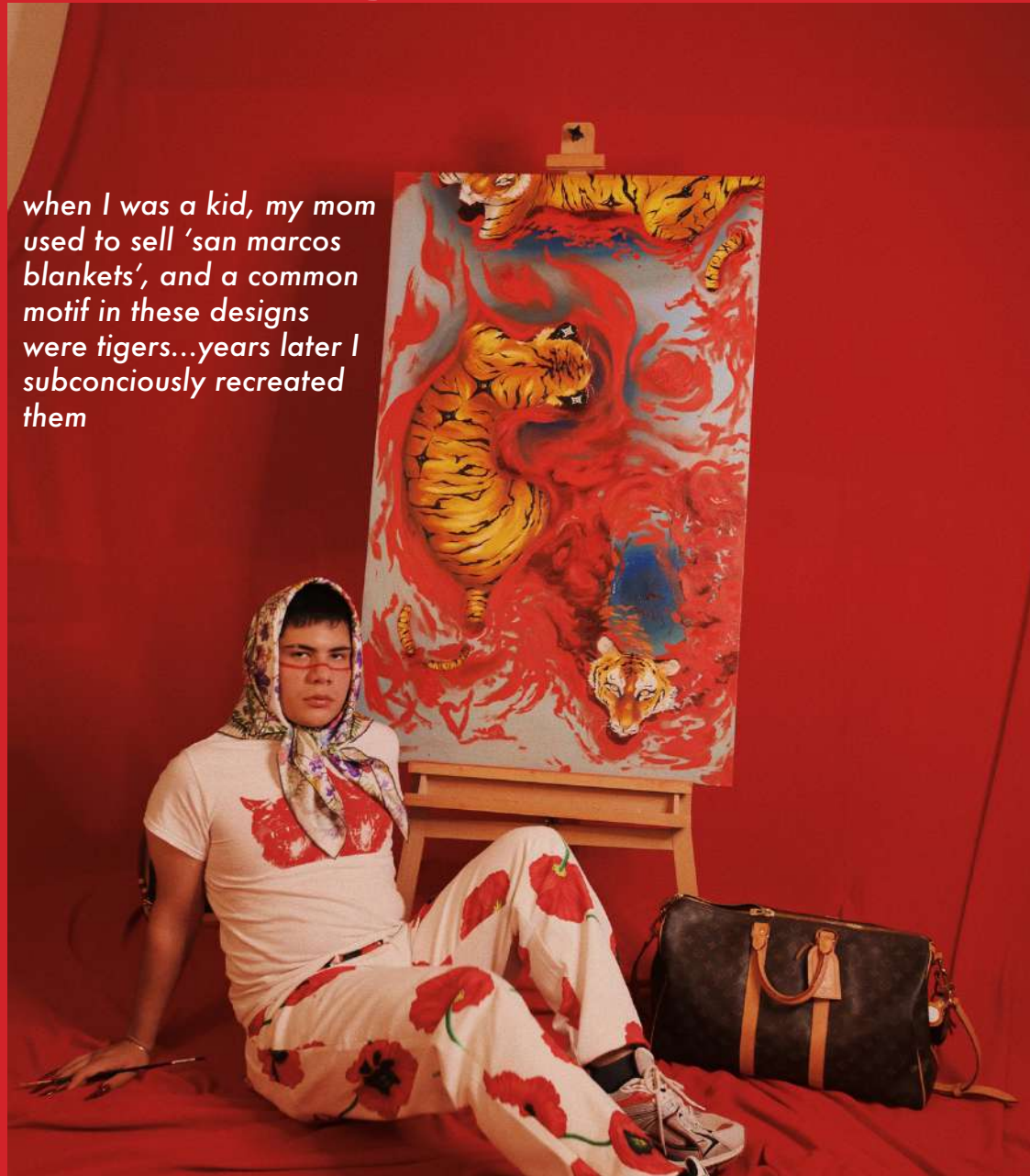

Perry's work has been displayed in the 'Made in California Group Show, 2024' at the Brea Gallery and the "Desde Los Clelos, 2024" show at the Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art & Culture. Their works have also been recognized by industry leaders such as Adobe and Tik Tok.
