Recommendation(s)

That the City Council:

1. Approve the slate of Mayoral nominees for various advisory bodies.

SUMMARY

There are several Advisory Boards and Commissions with member terms that have expired. As part of the regular appointment process, these vacancies are being reviewed to ensure continued representation, community engagement, and alignment with the City's goals and priorities. The following are Mayor's nominations based on the recommendations received from Councilmembers. Pursuant to Legislative Policy 1.10 – Section III. Appointment Procedures.

A. Appointments – *Pursuant to state law, the mayor shall make all advisory board and commissioner appointments subject to the approval of a majority vote of the entire membership of the city council in an open session meeting of the city council, based on nominations or recommendations submitted by each district councilmember for those*

member seats designated for district-based appointments. This is intended to ensure that there is representation of each district on each advisory board and commission. The mayor is authorized to appoint, subject to approval by majority vote of the entire membership of the city council any additional members to any advisory board or commission that already has a representative from each district who was nominated or recommended by the respective district councilmember, provided that such additional members do not result in disproportionate representation by any given district on the respective advisory board or commission. The mayor may appoint alternate members to advisory boards and commissions subject to approval by majority vote of the entire membership of the city council provided that such appointments do not result in disproportionate representation by any given district on the respective advisory board or commission.
