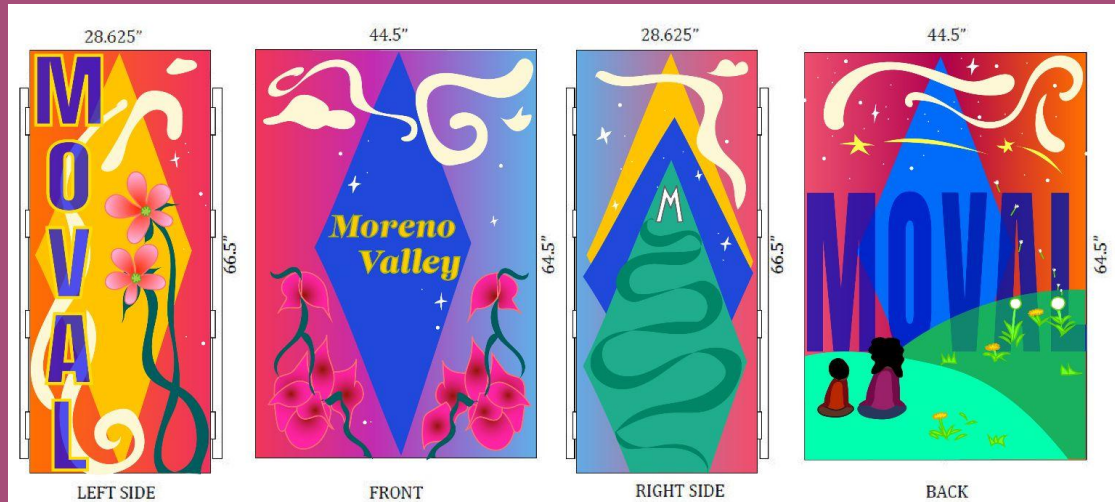
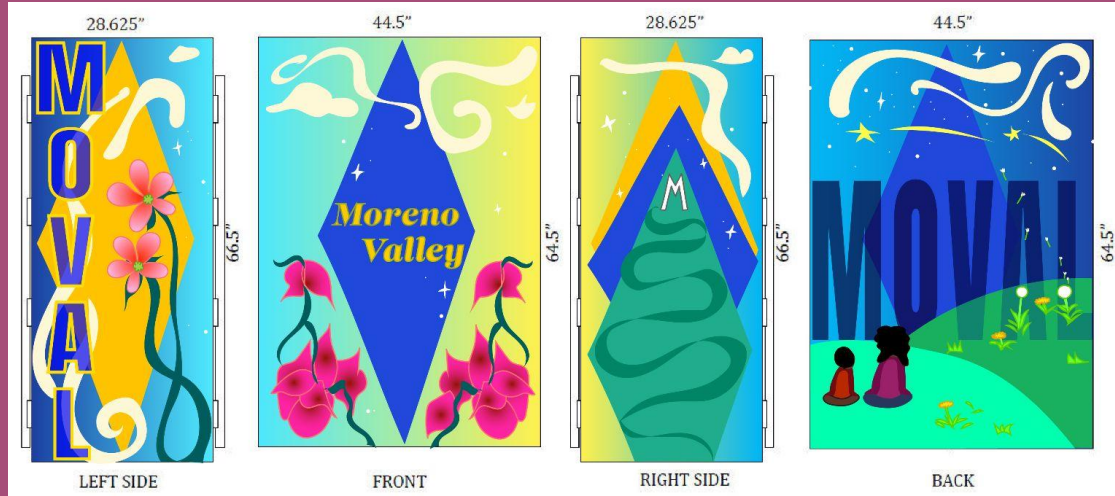
Three most preferred utility box locations
