

Applicant Introduction: Brandon Carn

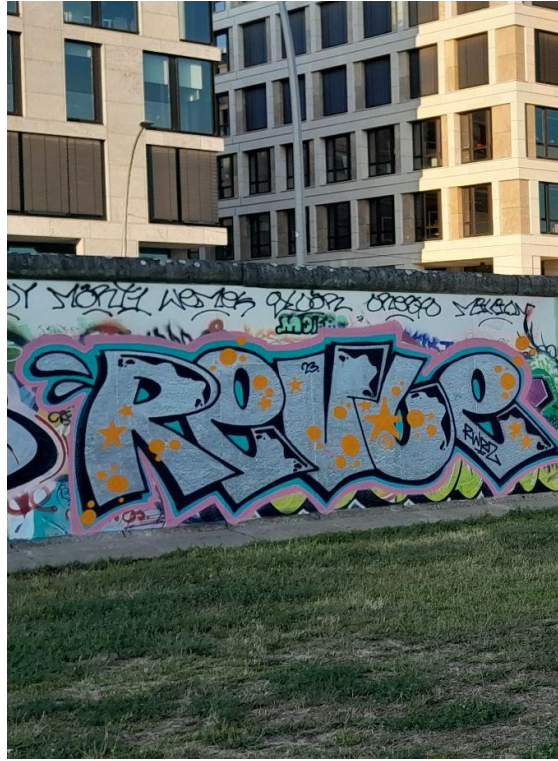
- Mural painter, educator graphic designer, and community volunteer.

Utility Box Wrap Proposal: “From Stage to Sky at March Field, California”



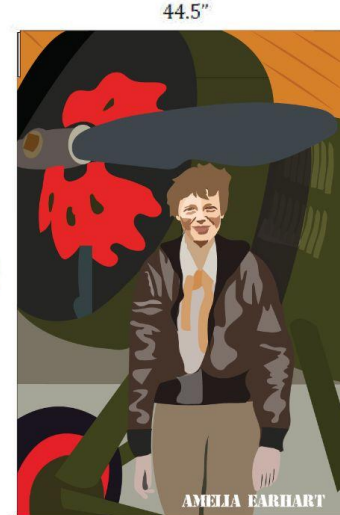
LEFT SIDE

General Henry “Hap” Arnold: First five star general of the US Air Force and former commander of March Field who invited movie stars and celebrities on post to promote the military and aviation.

Bob Hope: Began his USO comedy style shows at the March Field theater in May 1941 that later went worldwide. He also invested in racing events on the base and became partial owner of Riverside International Raceway and golfed with Air Force personnel for decades.

Amelia Earhart: Invited by base commander Henry “Hap” Arnold to use March Field to test aircraft, speak, visit, and attend displays to promote public aviation and women’s role in it. Frequent guest of the Mission Inn and friends of Frank Miller’s daughter Alice. Her image is of her in front of a P-12 Peashooter at March Field in 1935.

Location Proposal: Intersections of Cactus Avenue and Elsworth Avenue or Cactus Avenue and Heacock Street, or Cactus and Graham Avenue. These are visible not only to the community around March ARB but soldiers and Marines who use it monthly to fly to and from US bases worldwide.
