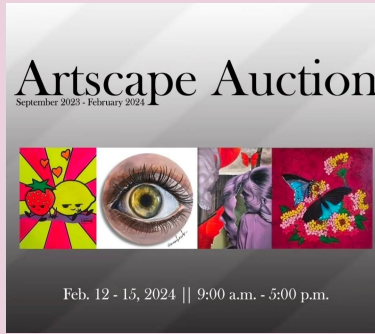
# Artists and Art instructor.

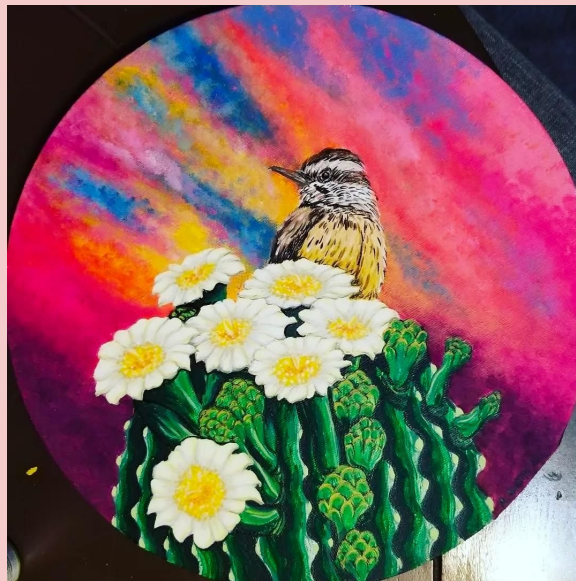
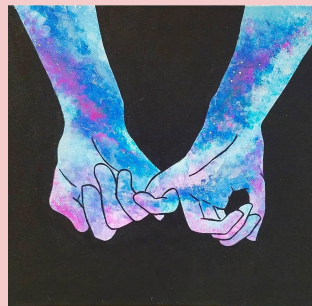
I recently taught 2 free to the public art classes for the Palos Verde Library District. The classes were at full capacity at 35 painters per class.

Theme is Blending in. I wanted this box to blend into its surroundings. I wanted to create something calm and subtle.

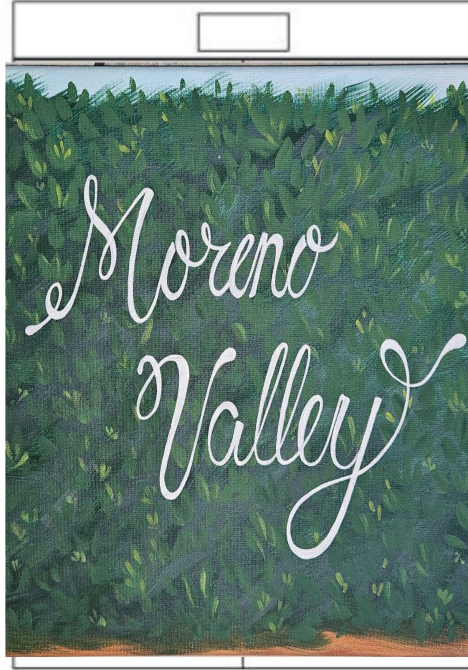

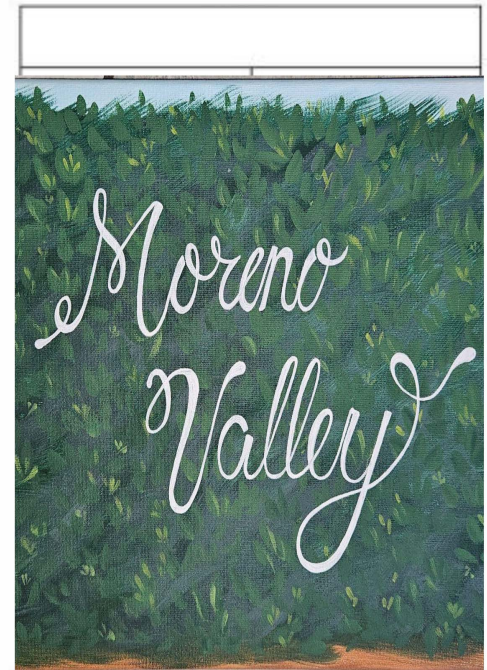

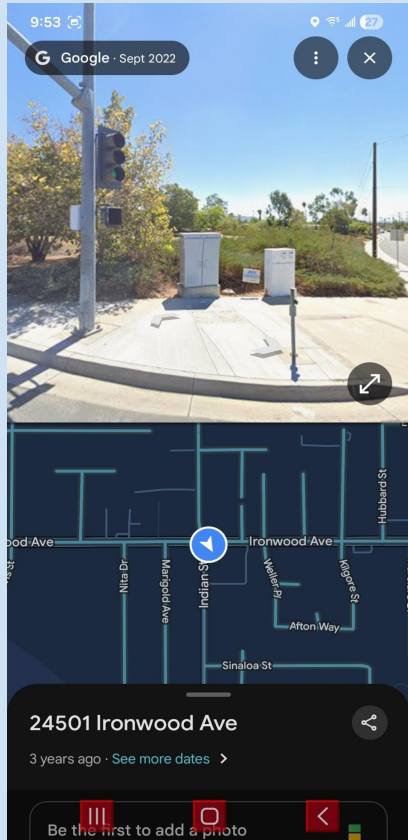
