Recommendation(s)

1. Appoint a Delegate, Mayor Ulises Cabrera, and an Alternate, Mayor Pro Tem Erlan Gonzalez, to the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) Annual General Assembly on May 7, 2026.
2. Direct staff to submit the names to SCAG.

SUMMARY

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) 2026 Regional Conference and General Assembly is scheduled for Thursday, May 7, 2026. At this meeting, the

SCAG membership will consider and take action on resolutions and/or bylaws that establish SCAG policy.

An important part of the Regional Conference is the Annual Business conducted at the General Assembly. The City must designate a voting delegate and an alternate, one of whom may vote if the designated voting delegate is unable to serve. Designation of a voting delegate requires City Council action.

SCAG has requested that attending cities submit a Minute Excerpt of the Council action appointing the City's voting delegate and alternate.

Staff recommends that Council by motion vote to appoint a delegate and an alternate.
