

**EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
MANAGER OF THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL/CITY CLERK**

(Second Amendment)

This Second Amendment ("AMENDMENT") amends the Employment Agreement ("AGREEMENT") dated May 6, 2025, and any amendments thereto, by and between the City of Moreno Valley, California ("CITY"), a California municipal corporation and general law city, and Marta Patricia Rodriguez ("EMPLOYEE"), collectively the "Parties."

This AMENDMENT is entered into on November 19, 2025, by and between CITY and EMPLOYEE on the following terms and conditions:

RECITALS

A. CITY, by and through the City Council, desires to continue to employ the services of EMPLOYEE as the Manager of the Office of Mayor and City Council/City Clerk of CITY; and

B. EMPLOYEE desires to continue to serve as Manager of the Office of Mayor and City Council/City Clerk in consideration of and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this AMENDMENT and the terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT.

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

In consideration of the promises and covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

Compensation. EMPLOYEE'S annual base salary shall be increased by 24% commencing November 19, 2025.

Other Remaining Terms. All other terms and provisions of the AGREEMENT, which are not in conflict with the terms and provisions of this AMENDMENT shall remain in full effect during the term of the AGREEMENT.

Acknowledgement. EMPLOYEE acknowledges that she has had the opportunity to consult legal counsel in regard to this AMENDMENT, that she has read and understands this AMENDMENT, that she is fully aware of its legal effect, and that she has entered into it freely and voluntarily and based on her own judgment and not on any representations or promises other than those contained in this AMENDMENT.
