### **Recommendation(s)**

That the City Council and CSD:

1. Approve the Parks, Community Services and Trails Committee recommendation of naming of the new park located on the corner of Mystic Sky Avenue and Sunset Crossings Drive (Major cross streets are Alessandro Boulevard and Nason Street).

### **SUMMARY**

This report recommends approval of naming the new park located on the corner of Mystic Sky Avenue and Sunset Crossings Drive (Tract 38442). The 1.38-acre park site is in the Sunset Crossings Development. The Parks, Community Services and Trails Committee made a recommendation at their regular meeting held on February 5, 2026, to name the new park site Sunset Crossings Park.

## **DISCUSSION**

The City's Park Naming Policy was created to facilitate the process of naming new parks constructed within our City. Some of the criteria for the selection of names includes naming parks after a dedicated City street, avenue, or boulevard. If a park is located adjacent to a school site, the park may bear the same name as the school. Additionally, a park may be named after a housing tract that the project is located within.

The new 1.38-acre park site is in the Sunset Crossings Development and based on its location and in line with the City's Park Naming Policy, the park name "Sunset Crossings Park" is being recommended.

The neighborhood park will include amenities such as playground structures, picnic shelter, barbecue grills, fitness equipment, and a large turf area.

At its regular meeting on February 5, 2026, the Parks, Community Services and Trails Committee recommended that the new park site be named Sunset Crossings Park.

## **ALTERNATIVES**

1. Approve the naming of the park site as recommended by this report.
2. Do not approve the name as recommended and provide an alternative name for the park.
